

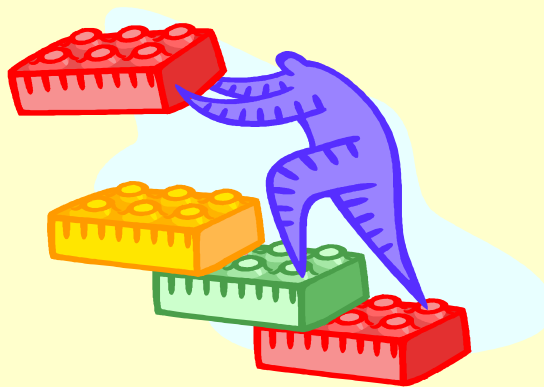


What are these templates ?

The eligibility templates were designed to provide school districts statewide with a means of identifying children who are speech impaired. Five templates have been developed so far: Articulation Disorders, SI Language Only, Language Disabilities in Children with Other Disabilities, Voice Disorders, and Fluency Disorders. School districts all over Texas can receive the needed training to implement all five of the eligibility templates. The TSHA has initiated a new project to develop eligibility criteria for culturally and linguistically diverse children.

How do I arrange for the trainings ?

- A. Contact the trainers in your regional service center area.
- B. Talk to the Educational Service Center to find out when they are offering the next training, or to ask for the trainings to be offered.
- C. Contact the TSHA State Office at 888-SAY-TSHA for the name of the trainer in your area or where trainings are being offered.
- D. Check the TSHA website CE listing at www.txsha.org for trainings



What is the order in which the template trainings must be taken?

- 1st- Take the Articulation Eligibility Template Training.
- 2nd- Take the SI Language Only Eligibility Template Training.
- 3rd- Take the remaining templates in any order:
 - ~ Language Disorders in Children with Other Disabilities
 - ~ Voice Disorders
 - ~ Fluency Disorders
